




Made for Hashimoto's Disease

Hashimoto's disease patch[™] is a product that was developed as a complementary therapy program that is accepted by Doctors and Practitioners as an aid to support and restore the thyroid function.



Symptoms:

You might not notice signs or symptoms of Hashimoto's disease at first, or you may notice a swelling at the front of your throat (goiter). Hashimoto's disease typically progresses slowly over years and causes chronic thyroid damage, leading to a drop in thyroid hormone levels in your blood. The signs and symptoms are mainly those of an underactive thyroid gland (hypothyroidism).

Signs and symptoms of hypothyroidism include:

- Fatigue and sluggishness
- Increased sensitivity to cold
- Constipation
- Pale, dry skin
- A puffy face
- Hoarse voice
- Unexplained weight gain occurring infrequently and rarely exceeding 10 to 20 pounds, most of which is fluid.
- Muscle aches, tenderness and stiffness, especially in your shoulders and hips.
- Pain and stiffness in your joints and swelling in your knees or the small joints in your hands and feet
- Muscle weakness, especially in your lower extremities.
- Excessive or prolonged menstrual bleeding (Menorrhagia).
- Depression.

Hashimoto's disease is a condition in which your immune system attacks your thyroid, a small gland at the base of your neck below your Adam's apple. The thyroid gland is part of your endocrine system, which produces hormones that coordinate many of your body's activities. The resulting inflammation from Hashimoto's disease, also known as chronic lymphocytic thyroiditis, often leads to an underactive thyroid gland (hypothyroidism). Hashimoto's disease is the most common cause of hypothyroidism in the United States. The Hashimoto's patch will aid and support the thyroid function while under attack.

It primarily affects middle-aged women, but also can occur in men and women of any age and in children. Hashimoto's disease is an autoimmune disease that affects the thyroid. It also is called Hashimoto's thyroiditis (theye-royd-EYET-uhss). The thyroid is a small gland in the front of the neck. The thyroid makes hormones called T3 and T4 that regulate how the body uses energy. Thyroid hormone levels are controlled by the pituitary, which is a pea-sized gland in the brain. It makes thyroid stimulating hormone (TSH), which triggers the thyroid to make thyroid hormone. With Hashimoto's disease, the immune system makes antibodies that damage thyroid cells and interfere with their ability to make thyroid hormone. Over time, thyroid damage can cause thyroid hormone levels to be too low. This is called an underactive thyroid or hypothyroidism (heye-poh-THEYE-royd-ism).

(Apply the Hasimoto's patch to the left side of the upper shoulder, replace every 3 days).
